



Call for Entries 2021

Help from Above

Humanitarian Aviation

Deadline for submission: 25 July
On-line show goes live: 01 August

Open to members of the Canadian Aerospace Artists Association and members of the Canadian Aviation Historical Society.

Limited to new, original work (created in 2020-21), any media, including photography and digital. Up to four entries per artist. There is no jury, but entries that do not conform to the theme or the guidelines laid out below will not be displayed in the show. There is no entry fee and there will be no prizes this year.

Theme: Anything related to the humanitarian use of aviation, including portraiture. Some broad categories (but not limited to these):

- Search and Rescue
- Medevac and air ambulances
- Disaster relief (hurricane, earthquakes, floods, famine)
- Mercy flights
- Aerial firefighting and smoke jumpers
- Emergency evacuations
- Specialized medical aircraft (e.g. Orbis Flying Eye Hospital)

Subjects may be military or civilian, government, UN, NGO, or private. Current, historical, generic or hypothetical. Not necessarily Canadian. Aircraft should be depicted engaged in some immediately apparent humanitarian activity.

Submissions are to be in the form of digital images in **JPG format**, with file sizes **no larger than 2 Mb**. Each image is to be accompanied by a **brief descriptive summary** of what's being depicted, especially if it's a particular historical event. We require **title/size/media/support** information (as applicable). Images may be re-sized to fit the gallery format, but will not be cropped.

The show will be presented on the CAAA website, www.aviationartists.ca and promoted via Facebook, Instagram and Twitter. Artists are encouraged to include pricing information and contact information, but will be responsible for handling their own sales.
